

Simple and Complex Sentences

1. aṅa raṅsan-p^hul nemnəkha-ø
1SG sun-flower like-NOM
'I like sunflower'.
2. amak-ø pan-kambai-c^hi
monkey-NOM tree-top-LOC
'The monkey is on the tree'.
3. ue nok c^huṅ-a
DEM.DIST house big-DECL
'That house is big'.
4. aṅ-an dravid
1SG-FOC dravid
'I am Dravid'.
5. uaw sonatc^hi məṅ-wa
PRN sonatc^hi name-FACT
'Her name is Sonatchi'.
6. aṅa dək^həm sa-aidoṅa
1SG head pain-PRES.PROG
'I have a headache'.
7. ue morot məṅ-sa nuk-ok
3F.SG person CLF:HUMAN-one see-PST
'She saw a man'.
8. ue morot məṅ-sa nuk-ok
3M.SG person CLF:HUMAN-one see-PST
'He saw a man'.
9. aṅa lekha porai-ok
1SG book read-PST
'I read(past) the book'.
10. ue uttəm robol kelegaba-aidoṅa nuk-ok
3SG 3PL football playing-PROG see-PST
'He saw that they were playing football'.
11. taniwaldo aṅa taʔon-c^hi raina naṅ?
tonight 1SG town- LOC go want
'I want to go to the town tonight'.

12. aṅa təŋʔok hanepdo cʰutti
1SG know tomorrow holiday
'I know that tomorrow is holiday'.

13. ue mitiŋ-mi seŋnaŋ reiŋna rama^{həm}
3M.SG meeting-ABL early leave tried
'He tried to leave early from the meeting'.
