

Word Order

1. kal^hen-∅ sonat^hi-aw nuk-ok
kal^hen-NOM sonat^hi-ACC see-PST
'Kalchen saw Sonatchi'.
2. kal^hen-∅ geteŋ sa-daraŋ-na kagalʔ-∅
kalchen-NOM PRN child-PL-ACC love-PRES
'Kalchen loves children'.
3. plider-∅ c^hoki-c^hi muʔ-ok
plundar-NOM chair-LOC sit-PST
'Plindar sat on the chair'.
4. dravid-∅ c^hisa-na p^hul pal-sa hən-ok
dravid-NOM c^hisa-DAT flower CLF:FLOWER-one give-PST
'Dravid gave a flower to Chisa.'
5. aŋ nok təi rəgənc^hi
1SG house river near
'My house is near the river'.
6. bəira p^hinak p^hakma-c^hi mu-ok
cat black wall-LOC sit-PST
'The black cat sat on the wall'.
7. marshin-∅ t^hai roŋ-t^ham saʔ-ok
marshin-NOM fruits CLF:FRUIT-three eat-PST
'Marshin ate three fruits'.
8. je morot-auwan məiya aŋa haba-c^hi nuk-okc^həm ue naramgaba
the man -whom yesterday 1SG field-LOC see-PST.PROG 3M.SG fisherman
'The man whom I saw yesterday in the field is a fisherman'.
9. aŋa p^han raopretgabao nuk-ok
1SG tree very tall see-PST
'I saw a very tall tree'.
10. c^haŋ naŋ soŋ-mi nokma
who 2SG village-GEN headman
'Who is your village headman?'.

11. naʔ kal^hen ma
2SG kal^hen INTERR
'Are you kalchen?'

12. ue kasina raiaʔ-∅
3M.SG slowly walk-PRES
'He walks slowly'.
